The 10th Annual 48 Hour Short Film Challenge took place February 14-16, 2014 with 61 teams participating from Arizona and California. There was a nice mixture of returning teams and wide-eyed rookies!

"We asked some of our veteran teams to come back and make one more film for our 10th Anniversary." said Jae Staats, A3F Director and Founder, "We also had quite a few new teams and past winners so the quality of the films this year was fantastic."

This year's guidelines asked the filmmakers to create 1-5 minute films using the Theme, Temptation, a Line of Dialogue, "This should be interesting." and a Button as the Prop where one or more characters had to press some sort of button.
