Guidelines will be revealed on the A3F [Facebook](#) page at 7p.m. on March 12 with your **completed** 1-2 minute film due by the 7p.m. **deadline** on Sunday, March 14.

Upload your film as either a **4K** or **HD** QuickTime or MP4 file to a popular file sending service like Wetransfer.com, DropBox or Google Docs.

The **link to your film** must be emailed to jae@thea3f.net by the 7 p.m. deadline or your film will not be eligible for our online **Showcase**.

Please **do not** post to Youtube or make your film public before March 27.

Make sure you **practice** encoding your files! In the past, several teams have been disqualified because they ran into problems encoding and **submitted** their films late.

All submitted films that beat the deadline and abide by the challenge rules will be posted on our online **Showcase** and eligible for **awards**.

Please abide by all rules and guidelines set forth by your local government officials and do not endanger anyone in the course of making your film.

Remember, this is a **One-Shot Challenge**, so you can only have one continuous take in your film with no cuts. Be creative and think outside-the-box!
