Our funding is through public donations, sponsorships and grants.

Scholarships are awarded on the basis of student's academic achievement, enrollment in their respective college programs, references and creativity in their essay answers. Scholars will be awarded a total of \$1,000.00 in tuition credits towards semester hours/fees at their respective school.

Eligibility

1. Will be enrolled full-time (12 hours) and taking classes within the School of Film & Theatre program at Scottsdale Community College (SCC) or the Film and Media Production program at Glendale Community College (GCC) during the Fall 2025 academic semester.
2. Completed 12 semester credit hours at SCC or GCC with min. 3.0 GPA.
3. Filled out the necessary documents and met all requirements listed below.
4. Shows exemplary skills and a passion for filmmaking and/or writing.

Documents Required

5. A completed A3F Incorporated Scholarship application form.
6. An official copy of your college transcript and/or grade report.
7. Two letters of recommendation from non-family members.
8. A typed essay stating why you should be awarded a scholarship. Please include the following in your essay:
 - Personal and academic achievements, give specific examples.
 - Career goals, give specific examples.
 - Community activities or involvement, give specific examples.
 - What inspires you about working in the film or script-writing field?
 - Your favorite all-time movie, explain why?
9. Film a one minute video about how this scholarship would benefit you (can be shot on any device and make it as creative or straight-forward as you want, completely up to you!) *Video Requirements: Email video link to jae@thea3f.net, can be hosted on YouTube or Vimeo or send using a file-sharing website such as Wettransfer or Dropbox.*

*Only applications with a complete set of documents mentioned above will be considered for 2025 scholarship.
